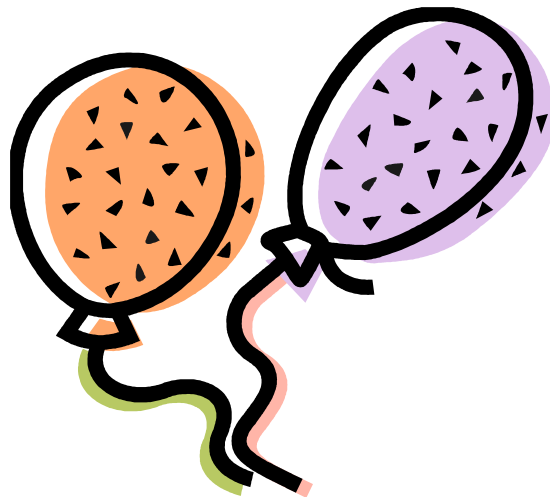


Birthday Book Club
